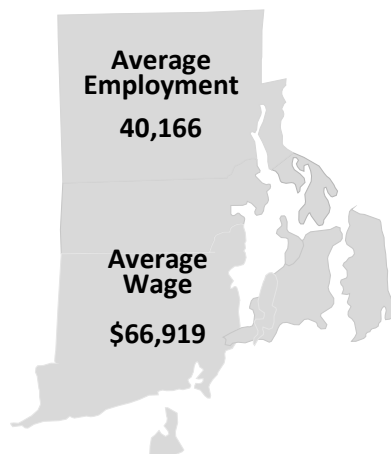

Durable Goods Manufacturing

Hard goods or goods that don't wear out quickly and last for a long period.

- * Represented **62.4** percent or **25,064** of the total manufacturing workforce
- * Average wage: \$69,811
- * Transportation Equipment manufacturing represented 24.0 percent or 6,017 of the durable goods workforce.



Nondurable Goods Manufacturing

Soft goods or goods that have a short life cycle.

- * Represented **37.6** percent or **15,106** of the total manufacturing workforce
- * Average wage: \$62,103
- * Food manufacturing represented 27.0 percent or 4,075 of the nondurable goods workforce.
