


Rhode Island Manufacturing Sector by Component 2022



2022 Total Manufacturing

Durable Goods Manufacturing

Hard goods or goods that don't wear out quickly and last for a long period.

- Represented 62.4 percent or 25,064 of the total manufacturing workforce
- Average wage: \$69,811
- Transportation Equipment manufacturing represented 24.0 percent or 6,017 of the durable goods workforce.



Nondurable Goods Manufacturing

Soft goods or goods that have a short life cycle.

- Represented 37.6 percent or 15,106 of the total manufacturing workforce
- * Average wage: \$62,103
- Food manufacturing represented 27.0 percent or 4,075 of the nondurable goods workforce.
