- APPLICANTS MUST BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD TO ATTEND THE PROGRAM.
- APPLICANTS MUST HAVE THE PHYSICAL ABILITY TO PERFORM THE WORK.
- APPLICANTS MUST HAVE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA, G.E.D. OR EQUIVALENT.
- APPLICANTS MUST HAVE A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE TO APPLY TO PROGRAM.

CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION IS CONDUCTED BETWEEN SEPTEMBER AND MAY.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS IS AVAILABLE BETWEEN APRIL 19TH AND APRIL 30TH.
