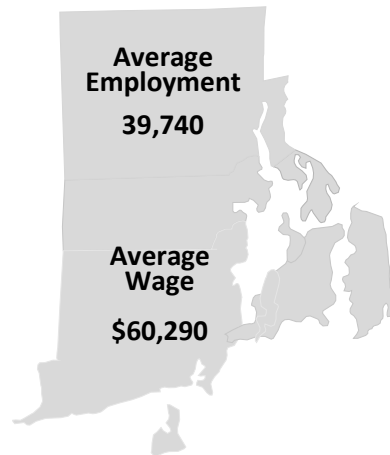

Durable Goods Manufacturing

Hard goods or goods that don't wear out quickly and last for a long period.

- * Represented **64.1** percent or **25,481** of the total manufacturing workforce
- * Average wage: \$62,360
- * Transportation Equipment manufacturing represented 21.1 percent or 5,388 of the durable goods workforce.



Nondurable Goods Manufacturing

Soft goods or goods that have a short life cycle.

- * Represented **35.9** percent or **14,259** of the total manufacturing workforce
- * Average wage: \$56,591
- * Food manufacturing represented 22.4 percent or 3,188 of the nondurable goods workforce.
