


# Rhode Island Manufacturing Sector by Component 2020



### 2020 Total Manufacturing

#### **Durable Goods Manufacturing**

Hard goods or goods that don't wear out quickly and last for a long period.

- Represented 62.5 percent or 23,400 of the total manufacturing workforce
- Average wage: \$65,887
- Transportation Equipment manufacturing represented 21.3 percent or 4,984 of the durable goods workforce.



#### **Nondurable Goods Manufacturing**

Soft goods or goods that have a short life cycle.

- Represented 37.5 percent or 14,014 of the total manufacturing workforce
- Average wage: \$59,891
- Food manufacturing represented 24.4 percent or 3,425 of the nondurable goods workforce.
