



Nationally, there were nearly 12.3 million jobs in nonprofit organizations in 2016. That was 10.2 percent of total U.S. private sector employment. The District of Columbia had the highest percentage of nonprofit employment, 26.0 percent. Vermont, Maine, Massachusetts, New York, and Rhode Island also had high shares of nonprofit employment. Nevada had the lowest share of nonprofit employment, 2.7 percent. Texas, Alabama and South Carolina each had less than 6.0 percent of private employment in nonprofit organizations in 2016.

## PRIVATE EMPLOYMENT IN NONPROFITS





- Nationally, those employed in nonprofit organizations earned an average wage of \$51,909, RI average earned \$49,667
- RI ranked 5th in New England and 22nd in the nation
- Massachusetts has the highest average wages in New England, and second highest in the nation
- Wyoming (\$1,081) has the lowest average wages in the nation

## EMPLOYMENT BY SECTOR IN NONPROFITS



- In RI, 58 percent of nonprofit employment is found in Health Care & Social Assistance services
- Educational Services is the second highest nonprofit employment sector in the RI and the highest nonprofit sector in the nation
- The remaining amount of nonprofit employment in RI was found in five industry sectors, representing 15.0 percent of RI's nonprofit employment
