Monthly Update

Month Ending: April 30, 2018

Unemployment Insurance

Initial Claims – 5,329 initial claims were processed during the month of April, an increase of 1,850 (53.2) from the previous month, and a decrease of 27 (-0.5%) from a year ago. Of the 2,576 monetary determinations issued in April 146 (5.7%) were monetarily ineligible.

Weeks Claimed – 44,634 weeks claimed were processed during the month of April, a decrease of 1,500 (-3.3%) from the previous month and an increase of 3,651 (8.9%) from a year ago. There were 40,962 payments made in April, which resulted in payments totaling \$14.3 million. There were 2,373 (5.8%) partial payments issued in April 2018 compared to 2,367 (6.2%) last year. The average weekly benefit payment was \$348. The number of weekly benefit payments is averaging 15.3 weeks per claim.

Workshare – 136 initial claims were processed for Workshare benefits this month, an increase of 12 (9.7%) from the previous month and an increase of 31 (29.5%) from April 2017. It is estimated that 43 layoffs were averted this month as a result of Rhode Island's Workshare program.

First and Final Claims – 1,948 first payments and 841 final payments were issued in April 2018. The current exhaustion duration ratio is 28.8 percent.

Non-monetary Determinations – 1,680 non-monetary determinations were issued during the month of April 2018. Of the 1,680 determinations, 1,014 (60.4%) were separation issues and 666 (39.6%) were non-separation issues. Denials were issued for 426 (42.0%) separation issues and 655 (98.3%) non-separation issues.

Appeals – 372 appeal decisions were processed with the Board of Review in April 2018. Of the 372 processed, 298 (80.1%) were filed by UI applicants and 74 (19.9%) were filed by employers. The Board upheld the director's decision in nearly twothirds of the cases.
