



TDI Monthly Update

April 2018

Temporary Disability Insurance

Initial Claims – A total of 3,796 initial applications for Temporary Insurance Benefits (TDI) were filed during the month of April. More than 78 percent of the applications were approved and nearly 22 percent were pending.

Payments – During the period 27,074 payments totaling \$13.4 million were issued. TDI payments averaged \$497 per week.

Temporary Caregiver Insurance

TCI claims – Of the 3,796 initial TDI applications filed during the month of April, 903 (23.8%) were Temporary Caregiver Insurance benefits (TCI). A total of 511 (56.6%) were approved and 392 (43.4%) were pending.

Type of Claim– Less than one-quarter (21.3%) of the TCI claims approved were for care of a family member and more than three-quarters (78.7%) were for bonding with a child.

Reason for Claim – The majority (76.7%) of TCI Claims approved were for bonding with a new born, followed by care of a spouse (11.5%) and care of a parent at (5.9%).

TCI Payments – During the month of April, 1,757 TCI payments totaling nearly \$950 thousand were issued. TCI payments averaged \$541 per week.

To Date – 3,841 TCI initial claims have been filed accounting for 24.0 percent of the 15,999 TDI applications filed in 2018. There have been 7,456 TCI payments issued to date totaling \$4,053,146.
