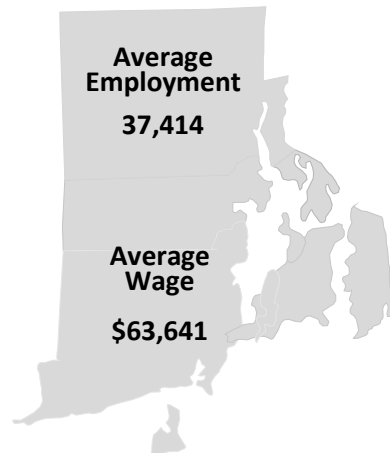

Durable Goods Manufacturing

Hard goods or goods that don't wear out quickly and last for a long period.

- * Represented **62.5** percent or **23,400** of the total manufacturing workforce
- * Average wage: \$65,887
- * Transportation Equipment manufacturing represented 21.3 percent or 4,984 of the durable goods workforce.



Nondurable Goods Manufacturing

Soft goods or goods that have a short life cycle.

- * Represented **37.5** percent or **14,014** of the total manufacturing workforce
- * Average wage: \$59,891
- * Food manufacturing represented 24.4 percent or 3,425 of the nondurable goods workforce.
