



TDI Monthly Update

June 2017

Temporary Disability Insurance

Initial Claims – A total of 4,038 initial applications for Temporary Insurance Benefits (TDI) were filed during the month of June. More than 76 percent of the applications were approved and nearly 24 percent were pending.

Payments – During the period 30,631 payments totaling \$14.8 million were issued. TDI payments averaged \$484 per week.

Temporary Caregiver Insurance

TCI claims – Of the 4,038 initial TDI applications filed during the month of June, 831 (20.6%) were Temporary Caregiver Insurance benefits (TCI). A total of 485 (58.4%) were approved and 346 (41.6%) were pending.

Type of Claim– Less than one-quarter (20.2%) of the TCI claims approved were for care of a family member and more than three-quarters (79.8%) were for bonding with a child.

Reason for Claim – The majority (77.7%) of TCI Claims approved were for bonding with a new born, followed by care of a spouse (10.7%) and care of a parent at (5.4%).

TCI Payments – During the month of June, 1,671 TCI payments totaling more than \$887 thousand were issued. TCI payments averaged \$531 per week.

To Date – 5,834 TCI initial claims have been filed accounting for 22.1 percent of the 26,438 TDI applications filed in 2017. There have been 11,662 TCI payments issued to date totaling \$6,194,300.
