



TDI Monthly Update

November 2017

Temporary Disability Insurance

Initial Claims – A total of 3,633 initial applications for Temporary Insurance Benefits (TDI) were filed during the month of November. Nearly 78 percent of the applications were approved and more than 22 percent were pending.

Payments – During the period 28,369 payments totaling \$14.1 million were issued. TDI payments averaged \$496 per week.

Temporary Caregiver Insurance

TCI claims – Of the 3,633 initial TDI applications filed during the month of November, 1,062 (29.2%) were Temporary Caregiver Insurance benefits (TCI). A total of 563 (53.0%) were approved and 499 (47.0%) were pending.

Type of Claim– Less than one-quarter (22.4%) of the TCI claims approved were for care of a family member and more than three-quarters (77.6%) were for bonding with a child.

Reason for Claim – The majority (76.0%) of TCI Claims approved were for bonding with a new born, followed by care of a spouse (12.3%) and care of a parent at (6.2%).

TCI Payments – During the month of November, 2,122 TCI payments totaling more than \$1.2 million were issued. TCI payments averaged \$558 per week.

To Date – 10,268 TCI initial claims have been filed accounting for 23.5 percent of the 43,676 TDI applications filed in 2017. There have been 20,439 TCI payments issued to date totaling \$11,069,126.
