



Nationally, there were nearly 12.5 million jobs in nonprofit organizations in 2017. That was 10.2 percent of total US private sector employment. The District of Columbia had the highest percentage of nonprofit employment, 25.6 percent. Vermont, Maine, New York, Massachusetts, and Rhode Island also had high shares of nonprofit employment. Nevada had the lowest share of nonprofit employment, 2.8 percent. Alabama, Texas and South Carolina each had less than 6.0 percent of private employment in nonprofit organizations in 2017.

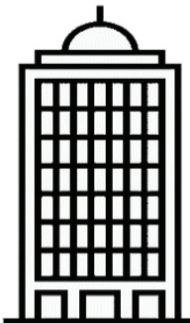

WAGES IN NON PROFITS



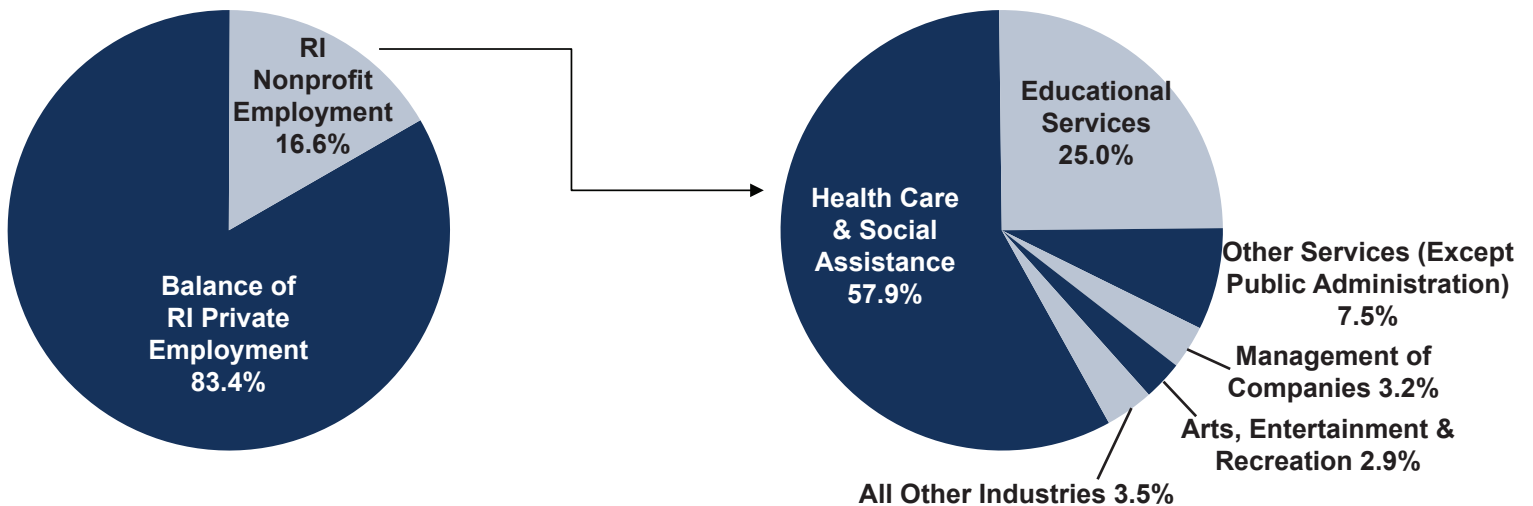

- Nationally, those employed in nonprofit organizations earned an average of \$53,667 in 2017.
- RI average earnings in nonprofits were \$51,249.
- RI ranked 4th in New England and 22nd in the nation
- The District of Columbia (\$74,671) has the highest average wages in the nation.
- Wyoming (\$35,350) has the lowest average wages in the nation.

NONPROFIT EMPLOYMENT BY INDUSTRY SECTOR



- In RI, 57.9 percent of nonprofit employment is found in Health Care & Social Assistance, while comprising 66.5 percent of national nonprofit employment.
- Educational Services (25.0%) is the second highest nonprofit employment sector in RI and the nation (16.0%).
- Other Services (except Public Administration) accounted for 7.5% of Rhode Island nonprofit employment, while representing 6.7% of the national nonprofit employment.
