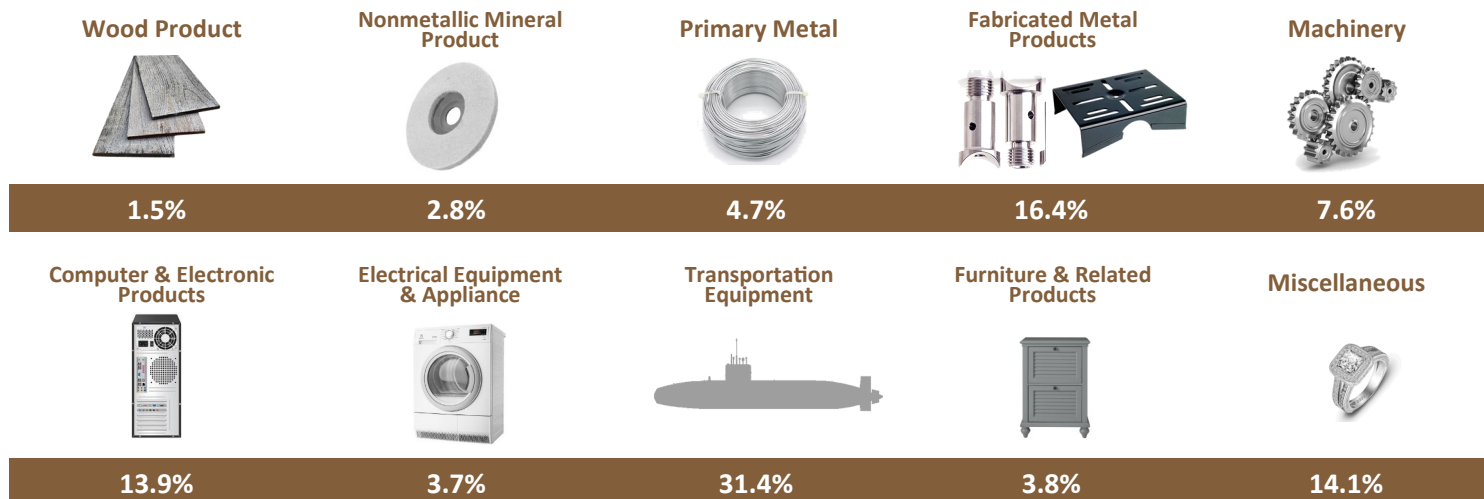


Percentage of Durable Goods Workforce

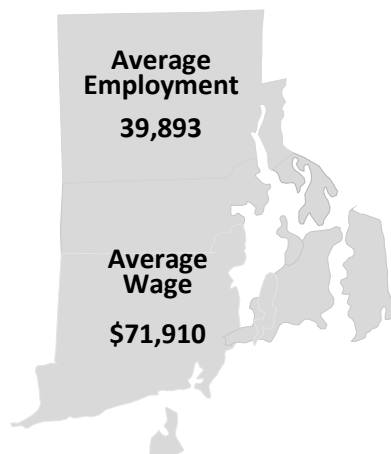


2024 Total Manufacturing

Durable Goods Manufacturing

Hard goods or goods that don't wear out quickly and last for a long period.

- * Represented **64.4** percent or **25,688** of the total manufacturing workforce
- * Average wage: \$74,896
- * Transportation Equipment manufacturing represented 31.4 percent or 8,067 of the durable goods workforce.



Nondurable Goods Manufacturing

Soft goods or goods that have a short life cycle.

- * Represented **35.6** percent or **14,205** of the total manufacturing workforce
- * Average wage: \$66,591
- * Food manufacturing represented 27.4 percent or 3,897 of the nondurable goods workforce.
