OUTLOOK 2020 - 2022

As we continue to recover from the pandemic, Rhode Island employment is projected to decrease by two percent (2.4%) or 12,500 jobs during the 2020-2022 projection period. At the Industry Sector level nine industries are projected to show slight growth from the peak employment of the first quarter of 2020, employment in the remaining 11 industries is projected to decline during this time frame.

The largest sector in RI, Health Care and Social Assistance, is expected to remain stable during this period with a slight decrease of less than one percent. Educational services, our second largest sector, is projected to add nearly 250 jobs during this time. Ranking third in employment, Retail Trade, is projected to continue at its current employment levels. The Construction employment is projected to grow by 1.4% with statewide employment increasing from 18,400 to 18,700.

Conversely, facing the largest decreases is the Accommodation and Food Services sector which is projected to decrease by twelve percent with employment dropping from 47,800 to 42,000. Self Employed jobs are projected to decline by ten percent with employment decreasing from 44,700 to 44,100. Substantial decreases, during this time, are also projected for the Administrative and Waste Services industry with a projected decrease of six percent.

The 2020-2022 projections are developed using models based on historical data, which in this set of projections cover the time period through March 2020; all input data therefore precedes the pandemic.

SHORT TERM PROJECTED EMPLOYMENT FOR RHODE ISLAND IN YEAR 2022

The occupational groups projected to grow at the fastest rates include Architecture and Engineering Occupations (0.5%), Community and Social Service Occupations (0.4%) and Education, Training, and Library Occupations (0.3%). These occupational groups are expected to generate 8,600 new jobs during the 2020-2022 Projections Period.

Conversely, Food Preparation and Serving Related Occupations are projected to decline by 9.7%. Building and Grounds Cleaning and Maintenance Occupations are projected to decline by 6.3% and Arts, Design, Entertainment, Sports, and Media Occupations are projected to decline by 4.7%. these occupational groups are expected to lose 14,500 jobs during the 2020-2022 Projections Period.
