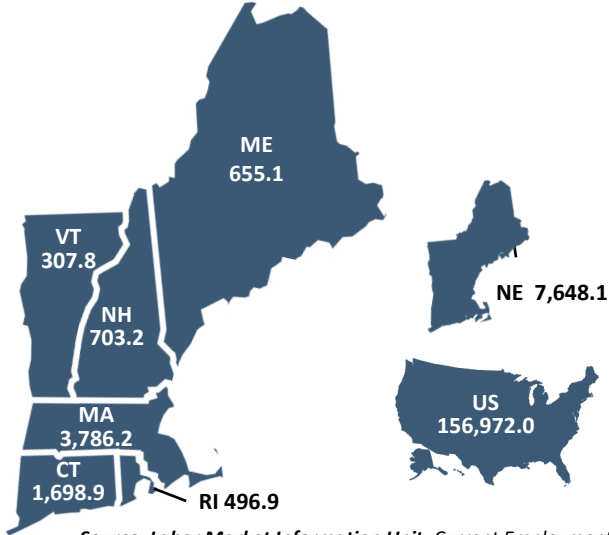

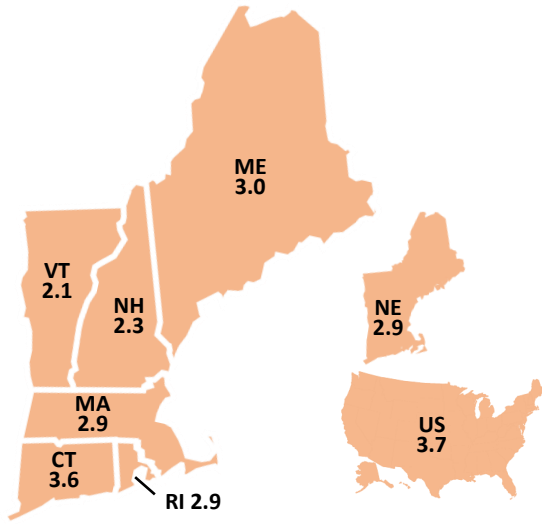

## Unemployment Rate



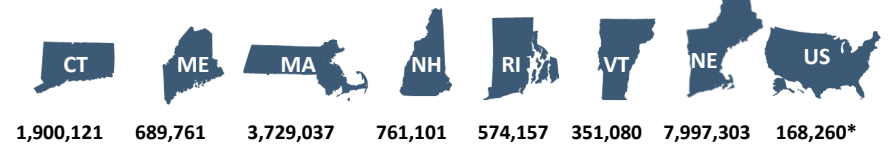
