## **Weekly Update of Claims Activity**

Week Ending: April 25, 2020

## **Unemployment Insurance**

**Initial Claims** – 12,921 initial claims were filed during the week ending 4/25/20, a decrease of 5,009 from the previous week, and an increase of 11,815 from a year ago. Of the 12,921 initial claims filed, 11,979 were due to COVID-19. Through April 24th, there have been a total of 140,554 COVID-19 initial claims filed. This week there were 7,154 Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) initial claims processed.

**Continued Claims** – 95,420 continued claims were processed during the week of 4/25/20, an increase of 17,161 from the previous week and an increase of 85,859 from a year ago. This week there were 26,384 continued claims processed for Pandemic Unemployment Insurance (PUA).

**Workshare** – gives employers an alternative to layoffs by allowing employees to work reduced hours and collect a percentage of regular UI benefits to compensate for lost pay. This week, 57 initial claims and 1,044 continued claims were processed. An estimated 16 layoffs were prevented this week as a result of Workshare.

**Exhaustions** – 230 individuals exhausted their regular payments this week, an increase of 8 from the previous week and an increase of 63 from a year ago.

## Temporary Disability Insurance

**Temporary Disability Insurance** – 1,241 initial claims and 10,443 continued claims were filed for Temporary Disability Insurance. Of the 1,241 initial claims filed, 598 were due to COVID-19. The average weekly TDI payment is \$501 per week. Rhode Island is currently paying an average of 8.3 weeks per new claim. To date there have been 28,332 TDI claims and 11,167 COVID-19 claims filed.

**Temporary Caregiver Insurance** – Of the 1,241 TDI initial claims, 461 (37.1%) were TCI Claims. This week 945 TCI payments were issued totaling \$473,127. The average weekly TCI payment was \$501. Of the 28,332 TDI claims filed in 2020, 7,128 or 25.2% were TCI claims. This week a total of 80 COVID-19 related TCI claims were filed.
