## Weekly Update of Claims Activity

Week Ending: March 14, 2020

## **Unemployment Insurance**

**Initial Claims** – 1,092 initial claims were processed during the week ending 3/14/20, an increase of 407 from the previous week, and an increase of 207 from a year ago. Of the 1,092 initial claims, 552 were due to COVID-19. The number of initial claims filed to date is down 8.0 percent from last year and down 6.3 percent from two years ago.

Continued Claims – 10,470 continued claims were processed during the week of 3/14/20, a decrease of 384 from the previous week and a decrease of 1,053 from a year ago. The number of continued claims filed to date is down 5.3 percent from last year and down 7.9 percent from two years ago.

**Workshare** – gives employers an alternative to layoffs by allowing employees to work reduced hours and collect a percentage of regular UI benefits to compensate for lost pay. This week, 12 initial claims and 315 continued claims were processed. An estimated 4 layoffs were prevented this week as a result of Workshare.

**Exhaustions** – 139 individuals exhausted their regular payments this week, an increase of 11 from the previous week and a decrease of 6 from a year ago.

## Temporary Disability Insurance

**Temporary Disability Insurance** – 831 initial claims and 7,318 continued claims were processed for Temporary Disability Insurance. Of the 831 initial claims, 21 were due to COVID-19. The average weekly TDI payment is \$532 per week. Rhode Island is currently paying an average of 10.3 weeks per new claim. To date there have been 10,125 TDI claims filed.

**Temporary Caregiver Insurance** – Of the 831 TDI initial claims, 195 (23.5%) were TCI Claims. This week 437 TCI payments were issued totaling \$250,960. The average weekly TCI payment was \$574. Of the 10,125 TDI claims filed in 2020, 2,797 or 27.6% were TCI claims.
