

TDI Monthly Update

September 2020

Temporary Disability Insurance

Initial Claims – A total of 3,748 initial applications for Temporary Insurance Benefits (TDI) were processed during the month of September. Nearly 58 percent of the applications were approved, and more than 42 percent were pending.

Payments – During the period 29,622 payments totaling \$16.2 million were issued. TDI payments averaged \$546 per week.

Temporary Caregiver Insurance

- **TCI claims** Of the 3,748 initial TDI applications processed during the month of September 1,407 (37.5%) were Temporary Caregiver Insurance benefits (TCI). A total of 577 (41.0%) were approved and 830 (59.0%) were pending.
- **Type of Claim** Nearly 78 percent of the TCI claims approved were for bonding with a child and (22.2%) were for care of a family member.
- **Reason for Claim** The majority (76.4%) of TCI Claims approved were for bonding with a newborn, followed by care of a child (7.1%) and care of a spouse at (6.9%).
- **TCI Payments** During the month of September, 2,080 TCI payments totaling \$1.3 million were issued. TCI payments averaged \$606 per week.
- **To Date** 12,641 TCI initial claims have been filed accounting for 27.3 percent of the 46,307 TDI applications filed in 2020. There have been 21,672 TCI payments issued to date totaling \$12,077,152.
