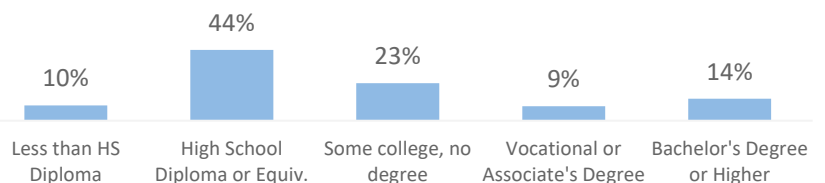

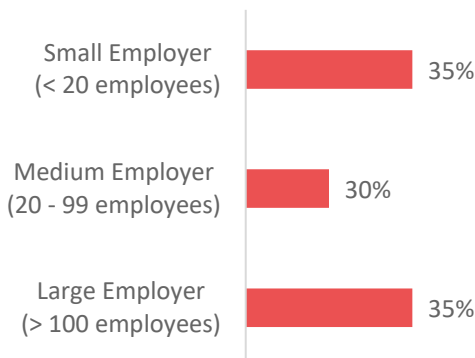

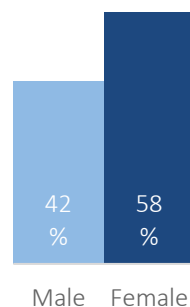

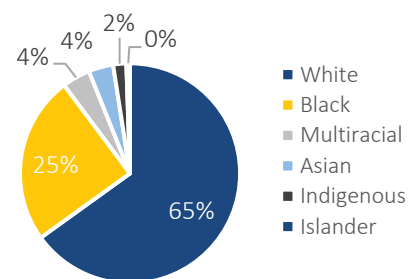
Cost per head
