

HIGH DEMAND OCCUPATIONS

The occupations with the most total openings will be the ones most in demand over the projection period. The 60 occupations listed are projected to have over 376,000 job openings and account for over sixty percent (61.4%) of the total openings through 2030. For most of the occupations listed, the need to replace workers leaving an occupation is projected to create more openings than openings created by new/expanding businesses.
