RE: RHODE ISLAND WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE COVERAGE CERTIFICATION

Effective January 1, 2006, (per RIGL §28-29-2(6)(iv)), insurers of temporary employment agencies or employee leasing companies will be required to issue the enclosed valid "Rhode Island Workers' Compensation Insurance Coverage Certification" (DWC-09) to the client companies of temporary employment agencies or employee leasing companies. The coverage certification is produced by the insurance carrier and will validate that coverage is currently in effect. Insurance agencies are not permitted to sign the coverage certificate; it must be signed by an authorized insurance carrier representative. Additionally, insurance carriers are required to issue written notice to client companies when a policy is canceled or non-renewed.
